Important changes for term time absences

We would like to make all our parents aware of changes announced by the government regarding the penalties for taking children out of school for holidays during term time.

From August 2024, the fine for school absences across the country will be £80 if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days. This rate is in line with inflation and is the first increase since 2012. Further information can be found here:

The competition is divided into 2 age categories:

How to enter

Entry is open to Bracknell pupils in years 3 to 6. You must submit your story by Thursday 20 June at 1pm to:

- your teacher (participating schools only)
- any Bracknell Forest library
- online in Microsoft Word or PDF format by email to <u>bracknell.library@bracknell-forest.gov.uk</u>

Entries must include:

- a typed or handwritten short story (maximum 500 words)
- the child's full name, school, age and school year
- be signed by a parent or guardian with their contact details (phone and email)

All entries must be submitted in English.

The guest judge is <u>Julie Pike</u>. She is the author of the children's magic and adventure stories, The Last Spell Breather and Flame Chasers.

Prizes

A winner and a runner up will be selected from each category. They will get prizes of Julie Pike's books, a book token and other book merchandise. A shortlist of 20 stories will each get short feedback notes of encouragement from Julie.

Winners and runners up will be announced before the Bracknell Book Fair. All shortlisted stories will be on display in Bracknell library. Winners and runners up will receive their prize from Julie Pike at 10am in the library on the day of Bracknell Book Fair.
